***At Home COVID Test Kits***

*This document is a Summary of Material Modifications (“SMM”) intended to notify you of important changes being made to the plan of benefits of Iron Workers District Council (Philadelphia and Vicinity) Health Benefit Plan (the “Plan”). You should take the time to read this SMM carefully. If you have any questions regarding these changes to the Plan, please contact the Fund Office at 215-537-0900.*

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The Iron Workers District Council (Philadelphia and Vicinity) Health Benefit Plan has partnered with its prescription drug benefits manager, Benecard, to cover FDA-approved over the counter COVID-19 testing kits. Although the Plan is covering these kits through Benecard, you do not need a prescription to purchase an over-the-counter (OTC) kit. You must, however, present your Benecard ID card at the time of purchase.

Each covered family member may purchase up to 8 testing kits per month. If you pay out of pocket for a kit at a participating pharmacy, you can submit a reimbursement form to Benecard, and Benecard will reimburse you for the full price of the kit. If you purchase a kit from a non-participating pharmacy, you can still submit a reimbursement form to Benecard, however, reimbursement will be limited to \$12 per kit.

On the Plan’s website, you can find a detailed description of how Benecard will be administering this benefit, where you can find participating pharmacies, frequently asked questions, and a reimbursement form.

The Trust Agreement and the full Plan documents are at the Fund Office and may be inspected by you free of charge during normal business hours. No individual other than the Board of Trustees (or its duly authorized designee) has any authority to interpret the Plan documents, make any promises to you about benefits under the Plan, or to change any provision of the Plan. Only the Board of Trustees (or its duly authorized designee) has the exclusive right and power, in its sole and absolute discretion, to interpret the terms of the Plan and decide all matters, legal and/or factual, arising under the Plan.
